Matters under discussion Calendar Generally

K1 Racing

We agreed on an outing to K1 in Buffalo Grove for Saturday March 7, most likely in the afternoon. Wayne Seely will follow up on details. For a discounted group rate we do need a guaranteed minimum participation.

Model Car Night-March

Blackhawk Farms Raceway

We have tentatively selected June 6th for our annual track event. It was moved from the proximity of the July 4th date to accommodate a request by BFR as another group wants to conduct a two day event. We agreed not to seek a partnership with AUDI. Wayne Seely has had conversations with the Lotus Club about possible partnering with them or, in the alternative, offering them a discounted rate IF they would guaranty a minimum number of participants. This is a work in progress and more details will be released as things develop. BFR did offer us a discount if we agree to do a two day event. A two day event would be approximately \$16,000.00 as opposed to about \$9,000.00 for a single day. The consensus is that we do not want to take a financial risk of a two day event.

We recently did get a check from AUDI in the amount of \$2,298.94 representing their share of the loss taken on BFR 2019.

Don Brubaker announced he is no longer willing to participate in the management of the BFR. We thank Don for his previous years of dedication. We will need to select an individual to pick up the responsibilities in Don's absence. An outing to the Sugar Grove Family Fun Center for the slick track outing remains an option. In the past we've done it during the Summer months on a Saturday evening. I anticipate sending out inquiries to gauge interest.
