

Tech Inspection Guidelines



Top ten items to check BEFORE you arrive

- 1. Tight suspension. Springs not sagging or broken, bushings tight, shocks not leaking, anti-sway bars secure.
- 2. Steering tight. Tie rods, ball joints, steering box, etc.
- 3. Brake pads less than 10% worn, preferably semi-metallic. OEM pads are okay, but will wear VERY quickly.
- 4. Battery secured with metal brackets.
- 5. Fresh DOT4 brake fluid is a good idea. DOT3 will boil with repeated heavy braking, causing loss of brakes.
- 6. Tire pressures For radial tires, start between 36-40 PSI. Soft tires greatly reduce your handling.
- 7. Brake lights MUST be functioning. Minimum of two.
- 8. Seat belts in working order. Passenger side, too, if you want a mentor to ride along. Helmets must meet Snell 1995 or later. Full shield in open cars shatter resistant cover in closed car.
- 9. Check all engine belts for wear and tightness. Loose or worn belts WILL FAIL under track conditions.
- 10. Engine mounts properly tightened. Loose mounts can cause damage to fans, shrouds, radiators, hoses, etc.

BONUS TIP: BE SURE TO TORQUE YOUR LUG NUTS BEFORE EACH SESSION.
